Unemployment Benefits	According to a <a href="#"><u>U.S. Office of Personnel Management fact sheet</u></a> , federal employees may be eligible for "Unemployment Compensation for Federal Employees," which is administered by state unemployment insurance agencies. The fact sheet notes "the law of the state in which an individual's official duty station in Federal civilian service is located will be the state law under which an individual's eligibility for benefits is determined."
