The Many Programs of Fresno Regional Workforce Development

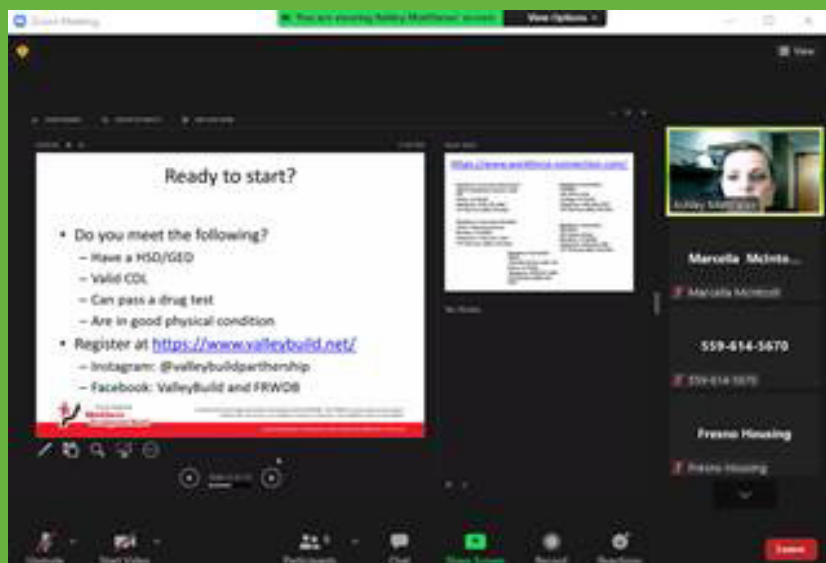

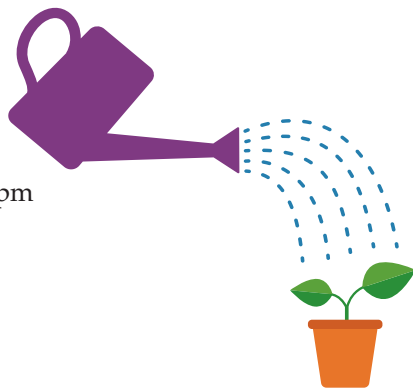
